Berlin, May 4th, 2017. Constraints in road transport in Buddestraße, Berlin Tegel, due to construction measures.



Within the scope of rebuilding and modernization measures at Tegel Center and in Gorkistraße, from May 8th 2017 the substitute bus station Tegel-Center in Buddestr. is removed. The following bus lines are affected by this: Bus 124, 125, 133, 220, 222, N22, N24, N25, N33. Apart from that, the mentioned bus lines run on their usual route. The construction measures will presumably continue until mid 2018.

Moreover, from June 26th up until July 9th 2017 (calendar week 26 & 27), a complete closure of Buddestraße is planned, hence the named bus lines will be redirected.

The Tegel-Center and Gorkistraße are getting refurbished and extended on a large scale. Primarily, the aim of this reconstruction is the revitalization of Tegel as a location for commerce as well as the modernization of Gorkistraße, being

one of Berlin's few tradition-steeped shopping streets. With its beautiful and modern architecture and an exceptional mix of tenants, the Gorkistraße will become an attractive centre for Tegel.
