Berlin, July 3rd, 2017. New time period concerning complete closure of Buddestraße, Berlin Tegel.



Due to construction measures, the Buddestraße in Tegel will be closed completely from July 24th 2017 until August 6th (calendar week 30 & 31), leading to traffic-related constraints. The following bus lines are affected by this: **Bus 124, 125, 133, 220, 222, N22, N24, N25, N33**. Apart from that, the mentioned bus lines run on their usual route. Diversions for the bus lines will be set up.

The Tegel-Center and Gorkistraße are getting refurbished and extended on a large scale. Primarily, the aim of this reconstruction is the revitalization of Tegel as a location for commerce as well as the modernization of Gorkistraße, being one of Berlin's few tradition-steeped shopping streets. With its beautiful and modern architecture and an exceptional mix of tenants, the Gorkistraße will become an attractive centre for Tegel.
